

NUHW members at USC get their raises—up to 9.25%

because of our contract that we won with NUHW's negotiators



In May, we voted to join NUHW at USC University Hospital. This month, we got our scheduled raises right on time, and saw our pay increase between 3% and 9.25% because of our contract that we won with NUHW's negotiators in 2007! It's the law.

When we voted to join NUHW, all of our raises and benefits, including scheduled raises, stayed in place. USC knew they had to pay what they owed or the government would step in to make sure they did, just like the labor board did at Kaiser.

“SEIU told us we’d lose our raises, but they were just lying to get our votes. We took control of our union and got raises as big as 9.25%.”
