

Federal government will protect our right to vote

Kaiser workers win agreement for a government-protected, vote-by-mail election to protect our rights

THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT'S National Labor Relations Board has heard our petitions from thousands of Kaiser workers, and agreed to run a government-protected, vote-by-mail election so we can vote NUHW and get our union back under members' control. Our election date could be set as early as next week.

Until today, SEIU insisted that we be forced to vote in the workplace, where managers and SEIU staff have tried to keep us from hearing both sides.

We can't depend on SEIU and Kaiser managers to tell us what we need to know about this important election.

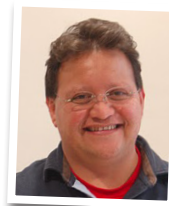
No podemos depender de SEIU y la administración de Kaiser para que nos digan lo que necesitamos saber acerca de esta importante elección.
