

SEIU's trustee negotiated with CHW behind closed doors—about OUR CONTRACT

We've learned that SEIU's appointed trustee negotiated with CHW management behind our backs on the day after the trusteeship was announced.

SEIU didn't inform our elected bargaining team of the negotiation, didn't allow us to participate, and still hasn't told anyone what was discussed.

We understand that an agreement was signed about our contract, but they won't tell anyone what it is.

In fact, now that SEIU has been caught red-handed, UHW Trustee Eliseo Medina has denied any discussion happened at all—even though CHW says he's the one who signed the agreement.

SEIU says it's "business as usual," and for them it surely is. But in our union, unelected appointees with little collective bargaining experience don't cut deals in secret without our elected bargaining teams.
