



# Let Us Vote!

**Workers denied the right to vote for eight months**

**Tens of thousands of California healthcare workers filed petitions starting in February** to quit the Service Employees International Union (SEIU) and join the National Union of Healthcare Workers (NUHW), an independent union founded by healthcare workers who want to be part of a member led democratic union - not one led by top down officials in Washington DC.

Those petitions should have triggered government-supervised elections within 45 days. Instead, the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) has allowed SEIU to stall the elections and take millions of dollars in dues from workers against their will.

After eight months, the NLRB has scheduled only three elections for workers to join NUHW. After two landslide wins by NUHW, SEIU blocked the ballot count immediately after the third election by filing frivolous charges with the labor board.

It's time for the NLRB and SEIU to stop the delays and let us vote.
