

Whistleblowers expose SEIU's crimes in Fresno election

Mr. Martinez says he was instructed by superiors to tell the workers that if they voted against the SEIU, they could lose their medical benefits, see their green cards or citizenship revoked and possibly be deported. He says he and other staffers were also told to pressure voters to spoil ballots that had been filled out for the NUHW.

...In all, he adds, he visited 550 homes. "We scared people. We took the secret ballot away from these people," he says. "It was wrong."

Mr. Martinez says he raised his concerns directly with [SEIU-UHW Trustee] Regan and other superiors. ...Six other Fresno workers confirmed parts of his account in affidavits.

Call for a full investigation

Urge the Chair of the Public Employment Relations Board to fully investigate the charges brought by Fresno homecare providers and SEIU whistleblowers.
