

Kaiser workers get out of SEIU

50,000 Healthcare workers petition for recognition of our union

Kaiser employees have the highest standards in our industry—in fact, Kaiser members probably have the best wages and benefits in the entire country. We were even the first to win pensions.

But we don't trust SEIU to fight for and continue to maintain these standards. It's been just a month since the hostile takeover of our union, and SEIU officials are already going behind our backs to bargain with Kaiser for takeaways.

SEIU also changed our bargaining team to eliminate rank and file members. Now two appointed SEIU staff are bargaining for 45,000 members.

That's why a majority of Kaiser's 50,000 workers have signed petitions to kick SEIU out and take back control of our union. We've filed our petitions with the NLRB and we're asking Kaiser to recognize our union of choice.

In NUHW, we'll have a voice again—and we'll have the experienced, trusted leaders we elected.



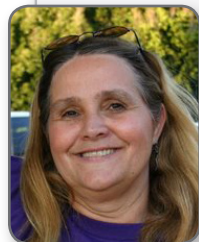
