

# The UHW-SEIU Million Dollar Club

Every year, UHW-SEIU members pay nearly \$90 million in membership dues. What happens to our money? The out-of-town trustees who took over our union in January have refused to tell us. But there are some things they can't hide.

## \$30 million to Andy Stern in Washington, DC

Right off the top, approximately \$30 million of our dues money goes to SEIU President Andy Stern and his cronies in SEIU's Washington, DC headquarters. What do healthcare workers get for that? No services, no financial support, no research, no education, and no information about how our money was spent.

## Outrageous salaries for Stern's trusteeship staff

While thousands of UHW-SEIU members face job loss and cuts to their wages and benefits, the top five staff Stern appointed to take over our union take more than a million dollars a year of our money while failing to protect us at work. And because they're appointed, not elected, we can't get rid of them no matter how bad they do.
