SEIU caught in collusion with employer

In one of the most outrageous acts yet of SEIU-Employer collusion, Olympia Medical Center gave “written last and final warnings” to every single shop steward for participating in union activity.

How do we know? Because SEIU staff, Rahul Vashney, met with the new Human Resource director, Keli Garcia, and asked her to write up shop stewards who participate in union activity. As a matter of fact, Garcia even “CC’ed” the write up to Vashney. When was the last time an HR director copied the union rep on a write-up for participating in union activity? Will SEIU now defend the shop stewards who were written up?

This shows how SEIU is working with employers, directly against the members. It's not just a violation of just cause, stewards' rights, and our freedom of speech. It's a direct violation of federal labor law, which protects every member's right to participate in union activity and express their opinion about the union.
